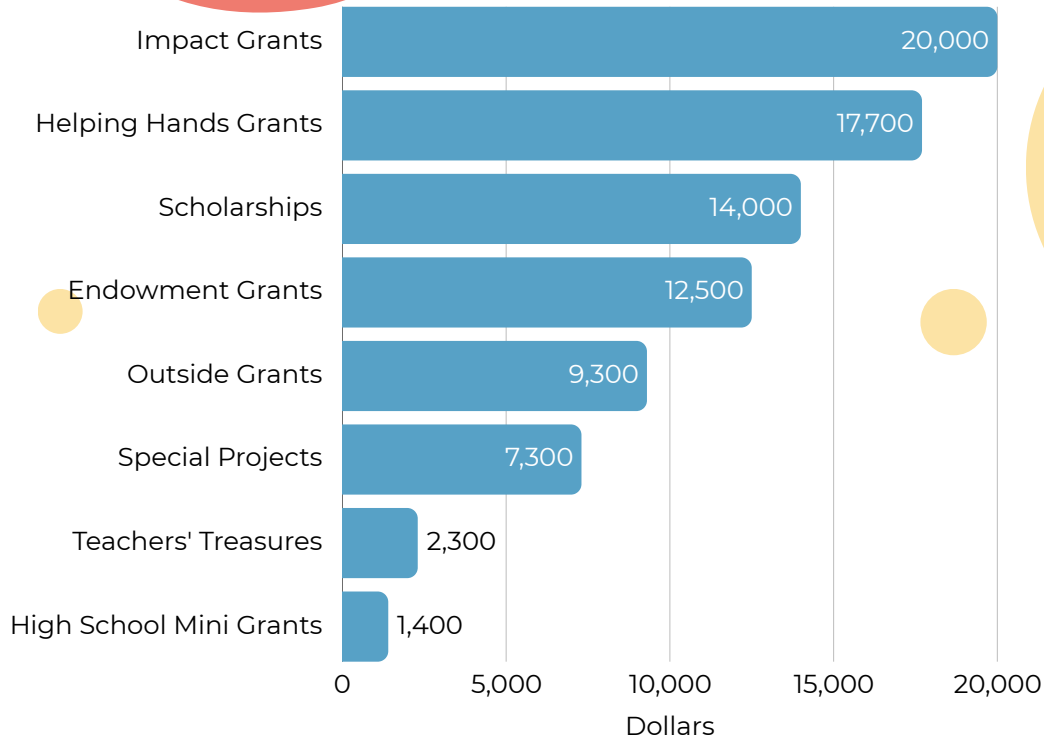

How did we support innovation and excellence in education this school year?



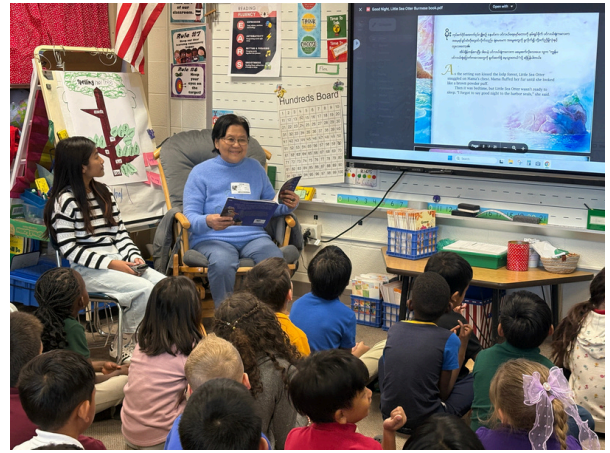
Thanks to our generous supporters, we invested nearly **\$85,000** in Perry Township this school year with opportunities such as:

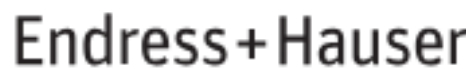
