



Impact Grant Guidelines

The Perry Township Education Foundation is committed to enhancing the educational experience across Perry Township. The Impact Grant Program aims to support initiatives that foster meaningful connections between schools, families, and the community. The grant aims to fund projects that promote inclusivity, enhance family engagement, and create opportunities for diverse community participation in educational activities. Applicants are expected to propose innovative ideas that align with these goals and demonstrate measurable outcomes, benefiting students, and fostering stronger school-community relationships.

Eligible applicants are Perry Township schools, departments, programs, grade levels, or individual educators.

Funding Details

- Applicants may apply to receive up to \$5000 to cover qualifying expenses.
- Funds must be used solely for the proposed project. Eligible expenses include supplies, materials, event costs, and guest presenters/collaborators.
- Grant recipients agree to make the approved purchases and complete the Final report (linked [here](#)) within three months of receiving the grant. Completing this step helps us evaluate how to best serve the students and educators of Perry Township and report to our donors and supporters. Failure to complete this report disqualifies the grant recipient from consideration for future grants.

Application Process

Submissions will be accepted on a rolling basis. The application form is linked [here](#).

Review Process: A review committee consisting of PTEF board members and relevant community stakeholders will evaluate the applications based on the following criteria:

- Quality of intended connections between schools, families, and the community
- Inclusivity
- Innovation and Creativity
- Alignment with the mission and goals of PTEF
- Alignment with the mission and goals of Perry Twp Schools

Notification of Awards: All applicants will be notified within two weeks of the application submission.

Program Requirements

Project Reporting: Recipients will submit a final report linked [here](#) detailing the outcomes and impacts of the project. The final report includes receipts for expenditures, photos of the grant in action, and a reflection on the impact made on the school, families, and the community.

Public Recognition: Grantees will acknowledge PTEF support and related community partners in promotional materials, presentations, and during any events tied to the funded project, including school/district social media, newsletters, and/or website (as applicable). A Grant Award (provided by PTEF) will be posted in a prominent location in the school or building for the duration of the school year. Projects will be featured on the PTEF website and social media platforms to celebrate the success and inspire future applicants.

Funding Accountability: All funds awarded must be used according to the original application. Any significant changes to the project or budget should be discussed with PTEF prior to implementation.
